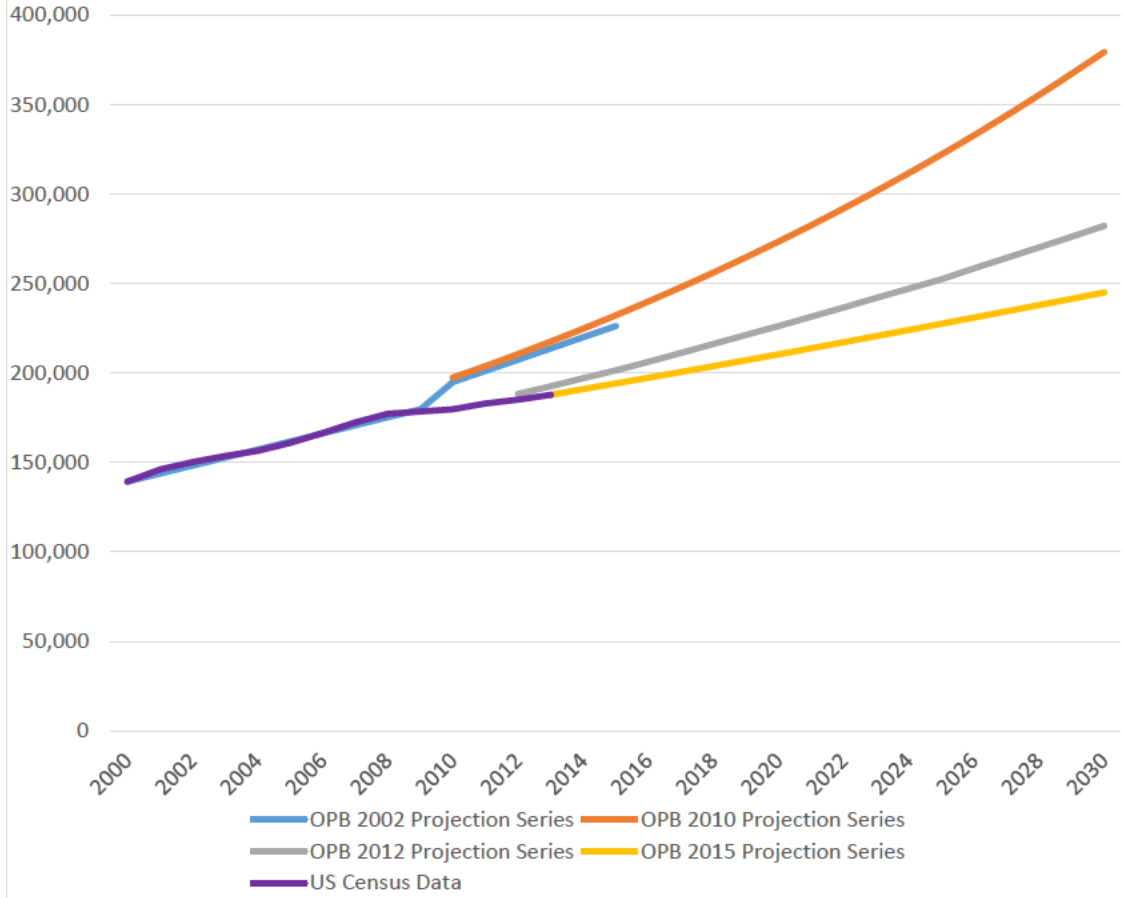


Hall County Population: Historic Projections, Current Projection and Official Census



Data Sources: The Georgia Governor’s Office of Planning and Budget (OPB) provided total state and county level population projection series for 2002, 2010, 2012 and 2015. I also utilized multiple United States (US) Census Bureau data sources. The decennial census 2000 and 2010 data provided total state and county level population figures. Total state and county level data for 2001 to 2009 was derived from the “Intercensal Estimates of the Resident Population for Counties of Georgia: April 1, 2000 to July 1, 2010, as of July 1, 2010.” The total Georgia population for 2011 to 2013 can be found in “Annual Estimates of the Population for the United States, Regions, States, and Puerto Rico: April 1, 2010 to July 1, 2013.” County level numbers for 2011 to 2013 are in the “Annual Estimates of the Resident Population: April 1, 2010 to July 1, 2013.” Per capita water use data for selected counties can be found in the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District’s *Water Metrics Report* (February 2011). The US Census also compiles annual data for a Building Permits Survey (<http://www.census.gov/construction/bps/>), which tallies the total annual new privately owned residential single- and multi-family building permits (for reported buildings).
